



Admissions Criteria

Admissions usually take place in September; however, we are willing to take pupils anytime through the academic year.

Pupils will attend the nursery for up to 15hrs/week and will be aged between 2 and 4 years.

Full time pupils between the ages of 4 – 11, will have a Statement of Special Educational Needs (SEN) and/or an Education Health Care Plan (EHCP). We will soon also be able to offer Key stages 3 & 4 to our curriculum.

These pupils' learning needs cannot be met from the resources normally available to a mainstream school.

On admission, pupils within the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) are generally not meeting their expected milestones.

Pupils at Key Stage 1 are generally working below National Curriculum standards. We are using Engagement Steps and Progression Steps as outlined in the Rochford Review.

For Levels 3-6 and at Key Stage 2, we are using Progression Steps and Performance Steps. Our Formal Learners follow the National Curriculum.

Pupils will be admitted when there is a vacancy within the appropriate Key Stage.

We are able to support children with:

- Complex medical needs, including Jejunostomy feeding, Blended food via the peg. We are fortunate enough to have a paediatric nurse to administer this along with three trained members of staff.
- Cognitive and learning difficulties including PDA and ASD,
- Severe learning difficulties

- Communication difficulties
- Hearing Impairment
- Visual Impairment
- Multi- sensory impairment
- Physical disabilities
