

We would love to have a place at The Llewellyn School and Nursery, I have been bringing my daughter for playdates with Louie for around 8 months and we feel this has been beneficial to our daughter's progression and happiness.

Our daughter has a rare degenerative disease of her central nervous system, as a result she has severe development delay, visual impairment, seizure disorder and functions cognitively at an 8-month's level. Our daughter is unable to stand, walk, talk or do much independently.

We were offered to join Louie in activities such as art therapy, music therapy and hydrotherapy. When we first went, our daughter was very reserved and reluctant to join in, we have seen a big change in her since then and she is more comfortable around other children and eager to get stuck in.
